

BCG40106 Cert IV in Building and Construction (Building)

What are the entry requirements?

There is a minimum requirement of year 11 (interstate or international equivalent). Mature aged entry may not attract minimum requirements. Students who have completed an associated Certificate III trade level qualification or can demonstrate at least four years continuous experience in building may also enter.

How much will this course cost?

In class study = POA or RPL Assessment = POA

Costs will depend on whether there is a large component of assessment or training and how much travel is involved.

How long will this course take?

Part time only (duration is dependent on how many modules are required to be undertaken following an assessment).

What materials/equipment do I need?

You will need to provide some mandatory textbooks, stationery and drafting equipment. You will be continuously assessed in both practical and theory, using our unique phased approach that helps you to logically build your skills. For further textbook requirements, ask for a copy of our Student Resources List for this course.

What will I receive?

On successful completion of this course you will receive a Certificate IV in Building.

Can I apply for credit transfer or RPL?

Credit Transfer may give you advanced standing (exemption) for parts of the course that you have successfully completed through other Registered Training Organisations or other courses.

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) is available where an applicant may have attained the skills and knowledge equivalent to specific competencies through previous training, work experience or life experiences. We will automatically assess you in this area when you enrol.

What about Special assistance?
