

CPC50208 Diploma of Building and Construction (Building)

This nationally recognised course covers the building theory and practice construction of residential and commercial buildings - Medium Rise.

What career opportunities will it give me?

This course meets the minimum technical qualification required to apply for a QBSA License as Builder – Medium Rise.

COMPULSORY UNITS

12 Units of Competency are required to achieve this Qualification.
6 Compulsory Units + 6 Elective Units.

You must first either complete Certificate IV in Building or provide evidence of the underpinning knowledge of the Units relating to the Certificate IV before undertaking the following:

BSBPMG 508A	Manage project risk

Electives (Choose 6)

CPCBC 5002A	Monitor costing systems on medium rise building and construction projects
CPCBC 5004A	Supervise and apply quality standards to the selection of building and construction materials
CPCBC 5005A	Select and manage building and construction contractors
CPCBC 5006A	Apply site surveys and set-out procedures to medium rise building projects
CPCBC 5007A	Administer the legal obligations of a building or construction
CPCBC 5010A	Manage construction work
CPCBC 5011A	Manage environmental management practices and processes in building or construction
CPCBC 5013A	Develop professional technical and legal reports on building and construction projects
BSBMGT 515A	Manage operational plan
BSBRK 501A	Manage risk

What are the entry requirements?

Clients who have completed the 15 Units of the Certificate IV in Building and Construction (Building) CPC40108 or provide supporting evidence to the BOSS Institute Assessor that you have the underpinning knowledge of the Certificate IV and have at least four years continuous experience in building may also enter. Please contact the BOSS Institute for an RPL Assessment Application.

How much will this course cost?

How long will this course take?

Part time only (duration is dependent on how many units are required following an assessment).
