

How the Assessment Process Works

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) is the acknowledgment of current skills and knowledge obtained through life experience and previous training in the building industry.

Employees with building industry skills and knowledge can have their current competence assessed, using a Training Package. This may give them a nationally recognised industry qualification with only, some, or even no, extra training.

An assessment does not aim to “Pass” or “Fail” a person with test, but rather to gather enough evidence to establish their competence. Many workers (especially those in the industry for many years) are already competent to the industry standard. They can have their competence assessed and recognised no matter how their competency was gained, allowing them to develop their careers by attaining a qualification (or further qualification).
